This specialized exhibition zone is curated exclusively for agricultural companies and institutions wishing to demonstrate their plant varieties, farm technologies, and sustainable farming methods in real farm settings. The showcase supports the broader goal of strengthening food systems through research, innovation, and climate-smart agriculture.

The objectives of the demo farm component include:

- 1. Showcase best practices in sustainable agricultural production
- 2. Promote adoption of climate-smart and digital agriculture technologies
- 3. Facilitate practical training for farmers, extension agents, and agripreneurs
- 4. Serve as hubs for research, testing, and product validation
- 5. Foster collaboration across the agricultural value chain

Demo Farm Information

Venue Information and Parking Arrangements:

There will be a parking area at the venue set aside for demo farmers and this will be utilized on a first-come-first-served basis. Access will be granted to all participants.

Demo Set Up Times:

Access to your zone for stand setup is available from 8am - 5pm on **Monday 18th August.**

Please note that expensive equipment should not be left unattended overnight.

Expo opening hours: As a demo farmer your demo farm needs to be ready by 8.00am ready to accept visitors from 9am to 4.30pm on **Monday 18th August**.







Plot Sizes and Rates

Each demo farm or plot is charged at Ksh. 35,000 and includes:

- A **20m x 5m(100sqm)** and **22m x 5m(110sqm)** Demo area for planting and technology showcase
- On-site water access
- Company signage on demo farm
- 2 exhibitor passes
- 2 lunch vouchers for 3 days
- Space to set up a tent or portable booth next to the plot

Larger plots or group plots can be arranged upon request.








Floor Plan of Demo Farm

Demo farmers are encouraged to showcase:

- Registered or newly released plant varieties (cereals, legumes, vegetables, fruits, etc.)
- Climate-resilient crops and sustainable farming techniques
- Farm mechanization tools or IoT-based innovations
- Soil improvement or pest management technologies

- Informational flyers or brochures
- Branded promotional materials (e.g., polo t-shirts)

These materials will enhance visibility and encourage farmer interaction.

Security and Safety

Security will be provided at the venue, but demo farmers are advised not to leave valuables unattended. Each demo farmer is responsible for their tools, seeds, or demo kits.







Payment Method

Payment for demo farms is required in advance of the event. Any demo farmer who fails to make payments when due, expressly waivers all rights in the reservation and use of space.

With regards to payments, Demo Farmers will NOT be issued their passes nor allowed onto their booths unless the organizers have received full payment of booths.

Demo Farmer Registration Packet

All demo farmers are required to pick their registration packet on Monday 18th August 2025 from 08:00 am – 6:00 pm at the demo farms area. The items include:

- 2 Demo Farmer Pass (es) issued on arrival. These passes are to be used for the three days to gain access to the demo farms and the conference sessions.
- Conference materials for the Exhibitor Delegate
- Lunch coupons for the 3 days for each participant







Please Note: Demo farmers will NOT be issued their badges nor allowed into their stands unless the organizers have received full payment.







Harvesting and Move-Out

Harvesting on demo farms may begin at the end of the last day of the exhibition. All demo farms should be cleared and all demo materials removed by 2200hrs on Friday 22nd August 2025 (unless extra move-out arrangements have been agreed with the Organizer).

No harvesting or packing will be permitted prior to the close of the show.
